COST

4 day camps = \$90 per student - covers professional instruction for four (4) days of camp & materials. *Please note: This reduced cost is possible due to generous support from the Black Belt Community Foundation and support from the BBTCAC Guild. Without this funding, the cost of camp would be \$140.00 per student.*

3 Day Camps = \$70 per student – covers professional instruction for three days of camp, and all materials. Camp may include additional information/instructions that will be sent to campers following registration (i.e. snacks, items from home for projects, etc...)

2 Day Camps = \$45 per student – covers professional instruction for two days of camp & materials. Camp may include additional information/instructions that will be sent to campers following registration (i.e. snacks, items from home for projects, etc...)

1 Day – With approval by BBTCAC Art Programs Director = **\$25 per day**

DEPOSIT of \$20 per student is due at time of Registration to secure placement in Summer Art Camp. This fee is *Non-refundable* and applied to the total fee due. *Only one deposit is required per family, for the summer.*

REGISTRATION is due BEFORE CAMP BEGINS.

*We *cannot* prorate class fees for students not attending the entire week unless approved by BBTCAC Art Programs Director.

DROP-OFF Caregivers should drop off and pick up their children at the SIDE entrance. Please do not drop your child off more than 15 minutes before class time.

PICKUP At the end of class, please pick up your child **promptly**. If you know you will be late, please call us to let us know!

SCHOLARSHIPS Scholarships, based on financial need, are available for campers – limited scholarships available, apply early!
Consider making a donation towards Scholarship support on your Registration Form.

MEMBERSHIP Black Belt Treasures Cultural Arts Center Guild Members at the ASSOCIATE LEVEL and above receive a 10% discount on most classes and workshops. Please inform staff at time of registration.

PLEASE NOTE Camp Slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis from completed Registration Applications. Class sizes are typically limited to twelve (12) students. Soap & Clay classes may be limited to eight (8) students. Once a class is full, no more students will be accepted - but a *Waiting List* will be established. There are no make-up classes unless classes are canceled by BBTCAC, due to unforeseen circumstances. Full Refunds will be given ONLY if BBTCAC cancels camp or due to extreme circumstances.
The schedule is subject to change, based on registration and/or calendar conflicts.
Class sizes are subject to change at discretion of instructor and staff.

DURING CAMP During the camp, students may work with the following mediums: acrylic paints, watercolors, oil or chalk pastels, clay, and various mixed media – please have students dress appropriately...
****in other words, do not wear anything to camp that should not come home with paint on it*
Students may bring a drink in a closed container. *No food please.*
Students are expected to attend all scheduled days of camp.
Grades 4-8 & 8-12 may leave the BBTCAC campus to draw/sketch in downtown Camden. We will let you know which day so that they may wear appropriate walking shoes.

CAMP ART EXHIBITION/RECEPTION

We may host an annual exhibition of art produced during Summer Art Camps, date TBA.

BEHAVIOR Please discuss the following Behavioral Expectations with your child(ren) before attending camp.

Summer Art Camp is a FUN, CREATIVE, and EXCITING place – but, in order for our staff and volunteers to be able to ‘do their job’ we must ask students to ‘do their job!’
